

## **PROFESSOR PAUL VALENSI**



Paul Valensi, MD, is Professor of Nutrition, Diabetologist and Endocrinologist, Head of the Department of Endocrinology-Diabetology-Nutrition of Jean Verdier Hospital at Bondy in France. He is also Director of the Laboratory of Nutrition, Metabolic Diseases and Cardiovascular Prevention at Paris-Nord University.

Prof. Valensi's main research topics are macrovascular and microvascular complications of diabetes and obesity, neuropathic disorders in diabetes and obesity, and prevention of diabetes. He served as Principal Investigator in several international trials, and invited speaker to international meetings (ADA, ESC...). Prof. Valensi is co-author of current French guidelines on silent myocardial ischemia and neuropathy in diabetes.

Prof. Valensi is member of the Executive Committee of Diabetes and Cardiovascular Disease EASD Study Group. He is past-Chair of Study Group of EASD on diabetic neuropathy, and of the French Study Group on Heart and Diabetes. In addition, he co-organized the International Diabetes Federation meeting in Paris in august 2004.

Additionally, Prof. Valensi is Associate Editor of Diabetes Metabolism. He has published around 230 contributive articles, and was Editor of several books.
